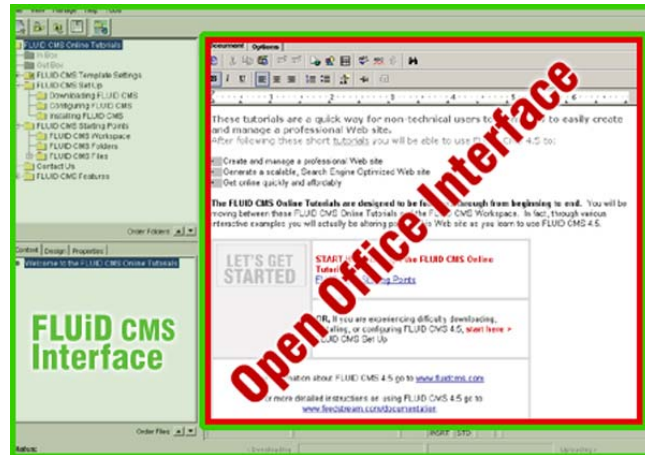




What is OpenOffice and Why is it Part of FLUID CMS 4.5?

OpenOffice.org *Writer* is a sophisticated word processing program that is very similar to Microsoft *Word*. The difference is that *Writer* was developed by, and is continuously improved by, a worldwide Open Source community of volunteer programmers. An estimated 16 million people have downloaded the free software, and community members have produced translations of it in over 30 languages.

FLUID CMS 4.5 has *Writer* built into it. A Web-enhanced version of the word processor handles the text and image editing within FLUID CMS 4.5.

There is no need, however, to download or install OpenOffice.org *Writer* separately—FLUID CMS is a stand-alone Web Content Management System. You can even run the full version of the OpenOffice.org Suite while you are using FLUID CMS.

OpenOffice *Writer* Saves Content as XML

Writer saves data in the industry-standard XML format, which separates your Web content from your Web design, so it is very flexible. It enables FLUID CMS to publish your content to various file formats such as HTML, PHP, ASP, and PDF. As a result, your site will be well prepared for formats that are increasingly popular, such as wireless; site upgrading and migration to other formats is effortless.

Writer offers the same features and functionality as any standard word processor. Anyone familiar with programs such as *Word* or *Word Perfect* will feel right at home with *Writer*.
